
#### **Deacons Beacon**

#### Clerk's Corner

Here is the current update from the last session meeting:

- Live streaming and in-person Worship services continuing.
- Communion observed in the sanctuary on April 2nd and April 6th.
- Read letter from Presbytery regarding Barnabas Grant (along with check for \$1500) for dishwasher replacement.
- Congregational meeting set for May 21st to elect Nominating Committee and vote on proposed HPC bylaw change.



- Congregational Family gathering set for June 11th to discuss current interim process and updates.
- Evelyn Unkefer transfer requested from Salem First Methodist Church.
- Approved extending Babette Reeves lease agreement for another year.
- Final HPC Employee Handbook reviewed and approved.
- Items collected during the Spring-cleaning day will be sold in an upcoming Rummage sale planned for June 24th. Money to go for church use.
- Susan Fry from Eden's Children's Village in Zimbabwe to visit on July 30th. Will speak to congregation.
- Buzz in sanctuary related to lights (light adjustment eliminates buzz).
- Moving forward with monument sign refurbish.
- Barnabas grant received to replace dishwasher.
- Discussed having Westcoat look at roof when replacing HVAC units (check for leak repairs).
- Need to do utility locate before completing installation of lending library.
- Reviewed HPC Technology upgrade request. Need to replace aging church computers. Authorized up to \$2,000 from the Kaufman Fund for computer replacement this fiscal year.
- HVAC update (2 units failing): Project cost \$40,000. Possible sources of financing include Barnabas Grant, Building Fund, Synod loan, Kaufman Fund, requests from congregation and requests from Hispanic congregations. Barnabas Grant request for \$10,000 submitted to Presbytery. Authorized application for Synod loan. Authorized special emergency capital Building Fund campaign to be presented to congregation for funds for HVAC units.
- Stay safe and healthy.

Online giving is available and ready to use for your convenience!

There are several ways you can donate online:

- 1. Download the free "Vanco Mobile" app on your iPhone or Android
- 2. Scan the QR code below.
- 3. Go to our website; www.hillsboropres.org and click on the "donate now" button.

You can set up a profile so it is easier each time you log in to give, or you can donate as a guest user each time. Donations can be from a checking/savings account, or a bank card.

We hope the option of donating online helps many of us who don't carry checks or cash every day, but still want to financially support HPC.

- 1. We don't "pass the plate" any longer, but we have a box inside the doors as you enter the sanctuary and you may place your donation there on Sunday.
- 2. You may set up a regular "bill-pay" through your bank that will automatically send a check to the church.
- 3. You can use our online giving "Vanco" and set up a regular payment with your credit card or with your bank account.
- 4. You may set up an automatic RMD (Required Minimum Distribution) or other automatic payment from your retirement account.
