A lot has happened since our last pastoral transition update in April, and we wanted to take a moment and bring everyone up to date.

In April, the Session submitted to Presbytery a "state of our church" report which included a copy of our Vision Team report, current membership and finances, and our priorities for the next 5-10 years. Presbytery responded quickly and thoughtfully, and it was clear that they understood our unique situation. Presbytery offered us two options in regard to the search for our next pastor: continue on the traditional transition path that will lead to full mission study and a national search, or permission to take an alternate path of doing a local search for a temporary supply pastor.

The Presbytery recommended that we bring this question to the congregation for their input, which the Session did at the Family Meeting and BBQ on June 11th. In that meeting the Vision Team shared a summary of their work, conclusions, and recommendations from their report. The Session then shared a snapshot of vital statistics for HPC over the last 10 years, including membership, finances, and staffing. Lastly, Pastor Brian explained the options from Presbytery, with benefits and drawbacks between doing a national search or local search in our current situation. The meeting closed with the taking of an informal "straw poll" which yielded an over 90% vote recommending the Session consider the local search option for our next pastor.

On June 27th, the Session met to discuss the comments, questions, and recommendations from the Family Meeting. The Session was thankful for the input and consensus of the congregation and voted unanimously to begin the process for a local search. A formal request has now been sent to Presbytery for permission to begin this search, and the Session has asked the Nominating Committee to pull together a slate of nominees to serve on the Stated Supply Pastor Nominating Committee (or SSPNC for short). The make-up of this SSPNC is a bit different than a traditional PNC, as it will be a bit smaller and requires at least one member of the Vision Team and one current member of Session to serve.

Our next update will come in September when we hope to share the latest from Presbytery and from the Nominating Committee. In the meantime, we ask that the HPC Family continue to pray daily for God to prepare the heart of our next pastor and to begin to make clear the way for them to join us in God's perfect timing.

HVAC Special Fundraiser Update

- 3. Go to our website; www.hillsboropres.org and click on the "donate now" button.


You can set up a profile so it is easier each time you log in to give, or you can donate as a guest user each time. Donations can be from a checking/savings account, or a bank card.
