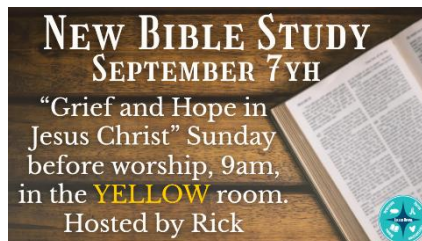
HAPPENINGS
