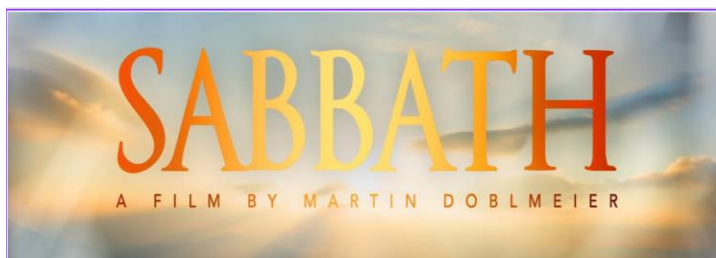


FELLOWSHIP HOUR

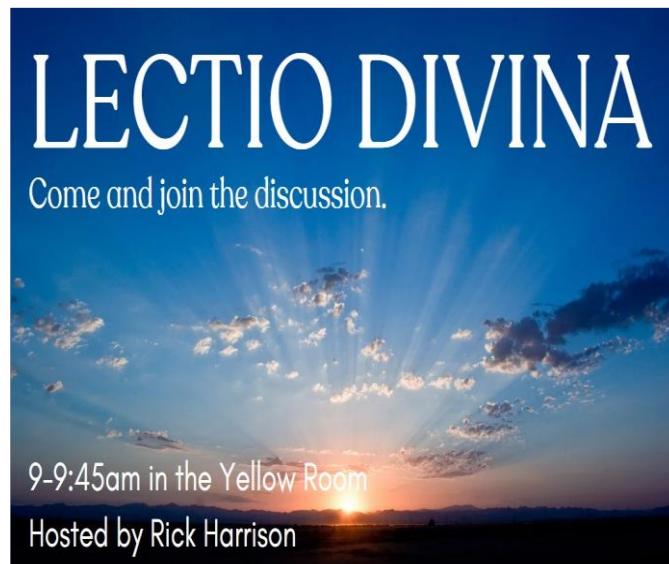

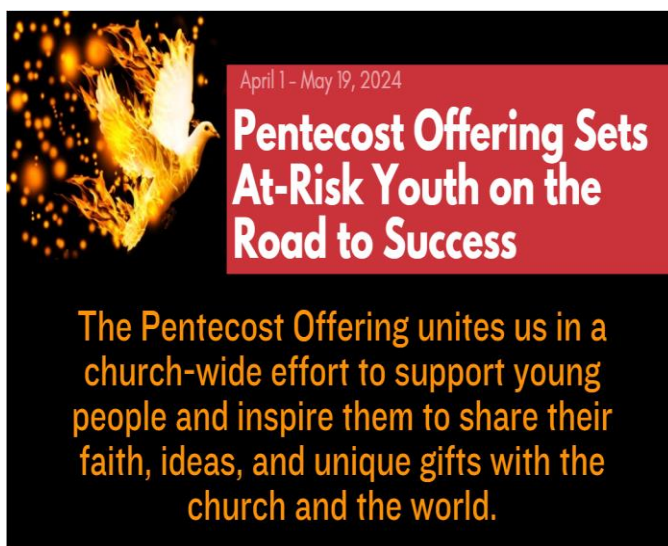
