PASTOR MESSAGE

Rev. Rachel Guevara

Happy New Year, Church Family!

What a wonderful Christmas and Advent we had together! It was so warm and bright, I didn't want it to end. Christmas is so often that way for many of us. In the last several days, I have had trouble finding my bearings this New Year. I love Christmas because of what and who we celebrate, and I also love the coming together of family and community that time of year. So, today as I write this, I take down Christmas decorations at home, knowing going through these routines reminds me of the passing of seasons, of warm connections with others, of worship of our Lord, and of what is to come next.



Property Project Status of as of 06-Jan-2026

A BIG THANK YOU to our congregation and
all the helping hands that help when no one is looking.

- 1. Inside Painting** - Thank You to Gary & Dana Gale. They have completed painting the Office and Yellow Class rooms. Painting of the Fellowship Hall is on hold, due to other project funding needs.
- 2. Manse Roof Replacement.** Completed 14-Nov-2025 by Ability Plus Roofing.
- 3. Sanctuary Roof leaks.** Have been communicating with 6 different contractors getting estimates for window and roof repairs. Hope to make a decision in January. NOTE: the roofing over the sanctuary is not related to the flat roof repairs completed during the summer of 2024.
- 4. Fire Monitoring Communication Device failure.** A vendor has been selected to replace the device. Hope to have the repairs completed in early January.
- 5. Kitchen Dishwasher Replacement** (has been on hold, since 2022, due to funding). A \$3000 donation has been made towards a replacement. Starting to research a replacement and the cost to have it installed.


February 1 – Guest Speaker + Laika Studios Spotlight


SACRED STEWARDS



HPC ONLINE GIVING

Online giving is available and ready to use for your convenience!

There are several ways you can donate online:

- 1. Download the free "Vanco Mobile" app on your iPhone or Android
- 2. Scan the QR code to the right.
- 3. Go to our website; www.hillsboropres.org and click on the "donate now" button.



You can set up a profile so it is easier each time you log in to give, or you can donate as a guest user each time. Donations can be from a checking/savings account, or a bank card.

We hope the option of donating online helps many of us who don't carry checks or cash every day, but still want to financially support HPC.

1. We don't "pass the plate" any longer, but we have a box inside the doors as you enter the sanctuary and you may place your donation there on Sunday.

2. You may set up a regular "bill-pay" through your bank that will automatically send a check to the church.

3. You can use our online giving "Vanco" and set up a regular payment with your credit card or with your bank account.

4. You may set up an automatic RMD (Required Minimum Distribution) or other automatic payment from your retirement account.
