

This is where we are financially as of the end of May. Income includes pledges, offerings, building use income, interest income, and designated income.

Did you know? There are some people who work in the background to collect the money and record it so that I can give you the end result each month.

John and Sandy McFerran are the smiling faces we see greeting us each week. At the end of the service, they remove the money that was dropped in the offering box and put it in the safe.

Once a week, Cindy Thomas and Sonya Baker come to the office. They count the money received by mail and the offering box. They enter the donations in the computer and hand each of us our giving statement at the end of the year. And then, they take the money to the bank to deposit it.



Gary Gale is the bookkeeper, and he records all the deposits in the computer system. He pays the bills and records those also. At the end of each month, he runs the reports that show the income and expenses for that month, and year-to-date.

My part of this is to simply look at the reports and write the numbers down to pass on to all of you.

Thank you, thank you to all these wonderful volunteers who work so hard to keep things functioning each week.

Online giving is available and ready to use for your convenience!

- There are several ways you can donate online:1. Download the free "Vanco Mobile" app on your iPhone or Android
 - 2. Scan the QR code to the right.
 - 3. Go to our website; www.hillsboropres.org and click on the '<u>donate now</u>" button.

You can set up a profile so it is easier each time you log in to give, or you can donate as a guest user each time. Donations can be from a checking/savings account, or a bank card.

We hope the option of donating online helps many of us who don't carry checks or cash every day, but still want to financially support HPC.



- 1. We don't "pass the plate" any longer, but we have a box inside the doors as you enter the sanctuary and you may place your donation there on Sunday.
- 2. You may set up a regular "bill-pay" through your bank that will automatically send a check to the church.
- 3. You can use our online giving "Vanco" and set up a regular payment with your credit card or with your bank account.
- 4. You may set up an automatic RMD (Required Minimum Distribution) or other automatic payment from your retirement account.




