Pastoral Transition Update

We are just a few months into our pastoral transition time and wanted to provide an update on the process so far.

We are thankful to have located an interim pastor so quickly, and to have Pastor Brian join us in leadership in September. As we had mentioned previously, he is serving on a one-year contract, which can be extended if needed. The timing of his arrival in the fall meant that our initial focus needed to be on the Stewardship Drive and setting the budget for 2023. With these steps now completed, the Session will be able to turn our attention toward the next steps of our pastoral transition.

Earlier this year the Vision Team was able to complete their work and submit their Vision Report to Session. Session will be reviewing that report at our Session retreat in January, prayerfully discerning our options and communicate with Presbytery about potential next steps. Once we have clarity, we plan to share those next steps with the congregation by this Spring, including a potential timeline for beginning our new pastor search. We plan to continue providing updates about our pastoral transition process both in worship services and in the Koinonia. The Session greatly appreciates your continued prayers during this time of transition, reflection, and dreaming.




- ·Second annual Chili Cookoff after the service on November 27th.

- ·Session adopted the HPC 2023 budget.
- ·Congregational meeting November 20th to elect elders (Jill Appel and Dana Gale) and deacons (Keith Upton and Sue Dever). Will install elders and deacons December 11th.
- ·Annual Congregational meeting set for January 22, 2023 after church service.
- •Pastor Search update: Session will be reviewing the Vision Study Report after the first of the year. At that point, a mission study for HPC will need to be completed (possibly using portions of the Vision Study) to be presented to Presbytery. Then the Pastor Nominating Committee can be formed. Please be patient and allow the process to work. In the meantime, enjoy the gift of our Interim Pastor.

Sacred Stewards

Here is the current update on our stewardship time. Last year, our pledged income for 2022 was \$160,740. This year, our pledged income for 2023 is \$164,960. That is an amazing 2.5% over last year.

I'd like to add a few other facts to that: we've had people move throughout the year – to heaven, to other states, to other places. The loss of their contributions was significant. What makes this stewardship time even more amazing is your generous increase in pledges not only covered those contributions but put us ahead on income over last year!

Amazing people, amazing God!

And this is where we are financially for the month of November (through November 20th). Income includes pledges, offerings, building use income, interest income, and designated income.

Monthly Income \$ 10,503.97 Monthly Expenses \$ 17,209.38 Net Income (Loss) \$ (6,705.41)

We had to pay approximately 3 months into Pastor's Pension account to get caught up with the new pastor. That was about \$5,350. It will now be \$2,250 per month. We had money in checking to cover this so didn't need to move money from savings this month.

Overall, from January 1st to November 20th our financials are:

Total Income \$ 152,112.50 Total Expenses \$ 170,756.26 Net Income (Loss) \$ (18,643.76) Our projected income and expenses for the rest of the year are:

Income \$ 14,730.00 Expenses \$ 12,252.98 Net Income \$ 2,477.02

Very nice to project income for the last month of the year!

As the song said: remember to "count our blessings and name each gift".

HPC Online Giving Available

Online giving is available and ready to use for your convenience!

There are several ways you can donate online:

- 1. Download the free "Vanco Mobile" app on your iPhone or Android
- 2. Scan the QR code to the right.
- 3. Go to our website; www.hillsboropres.org and click on the "donate now" button.

You can set up a profile so it is easier each time you log in to give, or you can donate as a guest user each time. Donations can be from a checking/savings account, or a bank card.

We hope the option of donating online helps many of us who don't carry checks or cash every day, but still want to financially support HPC.


- 1. We don't "pass the plate" any longer, but we have a box inside the doors as you enter the sanctuary and you may place your donation there on Sunday.
- 2. You may set up a regular "bill-pay" through your bank that will automatically send a check to the church.
- 3. You can use our online giving "Vanco" and set up a regular payment with your credit card or with your bank account.
- 4. You may set up an automatic RMD (Required Minimum Distribution) or other automatic payment from your retirement account.
