# **PASTOR MESSAGE**

Dear HPC Family,

October has flown by! In October, we completed our sermon series on James and started our series on Acts, our roof has been 95% repaired and new HVAC's installed, our church family celebrated the precious life of Dale Fulk and you gave me a most surprising and memorable Pastor Appreciation Tea Party. I continue to be so grateful for you all. What a joy it has been to be a part of this church family.

As we conclude our Stewardship Campaign, I invite you once again, to read and reflect on our key passage from Acts—the passage that has anchored us to our theme of GRACE for this campaign (Acts 4:32–35). It is God's grace that has brought us to where we are today as a church, and it is God's grace that invites us join God in what God is up to in community in the year ahead. What from the passage stands out to you? Do you sense an invitation in the passage?

32 All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they shared everything they had. 33 With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all 34 that there were no needy persons among them." Acts 4:32-34

This coming **Sunday, November 3 is Stewardship Sunday.** If you have not yet decided to pledge this year, bring that decision before God and ask the Spirit of Love and Grace to show you how you have been invited to contribute as a member of this congregation this year. Consider prayerfully, "How am I invited to embody and extend God's grace to this community this year?" And as we turn the corner into election week, may our voting and consumption of the election news be guided by that same question: How am I invited to embody and extend God's grace this election? In my voting? May our decisions and actions this week stem from postures of listening first to the voice of Wisdom, Love, Kindness and Peace and not from any one candidate or political party.

And as we approach Thanksgiving, I want to continue to challenge our entire congregation to try to **name three "graces"** each day that you have experienced (whether in a journal or aloud or by taking pictures like I do). Name or capture in images the small or large moments where you experienced God's kindness, gifts or blessings. Our attention to gratitude and giving thanks naturally turns to joy when we are committed to seeing and naming the ways God has extended grace to us! So let us give thanks!

  - 3. Go to our website; www.hillsboropres.org and click on the "donate now" button.




You can set up a profile so it is easier each time you log in to give, or you can donate as a guest user each time. Donations can be from a checking/savings account, or a bank card.

We hope the option of donating online helps many of us who don't carry checks or cash every day, but still want to financially support HPC.

1. We don't "pass the plate" any longer, but we have a box inside the doors as you enter the sanctuary and you may place your donation there on Sunday.

2. You may set up a regular "bill-pay" through your bank that will automatically send a check to the church.
